New business:

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1)	Grace period on HOA fees:

2)	Reminders for assessments:
-	HOACS has been instructed to advise residents on a quarterly
	basis of delinquent amounts.
3)	Water bills for the association.
-	Upon contact, Washington Water stated that they are not
	billing the association during the seasons that the water is
	turned off. There is no reconnection fee, or late payment fees,
	just that when we turn the irrigation back on, we will be billed
	as usual.
4)	Our insurances are current
5)	Question of form on our monthly reports from HOACS
	HOA will seek a definitive answer from HOACS
6)	Annual dues will be examined in the October meeting with the
	intention of presenting a full report to the membership at the annual
	meeting.
7)	New residents
	The gathering of information on new residents is not coherent.
	We are seeking a better way of notification to the HOA when a
	property changes hands.
8)	Speed limit
	Safety is the issue. Speed limit was discussed. Speed bumps
	have been discussed along with paint on the street to delineate
	the playground. Parents of small children are commended for
	their continued vigilance on this issue.
9) 10)	HOA secretary John Stava is identified as the HOA mailbox monitor.
10)	Fence and shed visibility issues were discussed, no action taken.
